

## Bequest

Paul the apostle has dictated in Italy to his beloved disciple Timothy the following word for the people of Israel in the letter to the Hebrews (Hebrews 13:7+25):

*7. Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.*

In the face of a jubilee, not only the celebrating human is to deal with, but also all, who were allowed to contribute to this career. There are to be mentioned the parents, the brother and the sister, the friends, and very surely also the teachers.

If we remember, which teachers have said to us in our life some of God's word, then the outcome can turn out to be sobering. In Germany, the number of atheists among the theologians in practice is particularly high, others are confused by this so much, that also they babble like them, one could not rely to the Holy Bible literally. These pseudo-pastors just did *not* tell us the word of God. So what?

If we remember even more, then may be noticed, that also besides the theology time and again there are god-fearing teachers, which during all burden of work sometimes cite the Holy Scriptures, to give orientation to their disciples. In physics, the best known of these teachers is the German Jew *Albert Einstein*:

During his school-days, he suffered by the atheism of the ending 19<sup>th</sup> century, and finally he decided, in spite of mean valued school marks, to attempt the heavy studies of physics, for by this he would be able to contribute constructively to the debate in the face of doubts against the Israelian calendar. This background information has been presented in his birth town Ulm at an exhibition on the occasion of his 100<sup>th</sup> birthday, and also later.

This means, that Albert Einstein of course knew and had internalized the Holy Scriptures. The prophet Ezekiel says (Ezekiel 22:30):

*30. And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.*

Albert Einstein allowed to be found and attempted among mainly atheistic experts to look for alternatives at specialist level. Therefore, his big research result is named *relativity theory*, thus an alternative to the dominant atheism of his colleagues has been formulated. In the year 1927, Albert Einstein risked during a conference, where the quantum mechanics of Heisenberg and Schroedinger was introduced, to give the following remark: „*This cannot be in all the very Jacob: The Old one does not throw the dice.*“ It is the best known of his cites, being delivered in numberless variants.

This means, that he is mainly understood by the one, who knows and obeys the messages of the Holy Scriptures. Thus in his last book, which appeared two years after his death, the biblical interpretation of the rainbow is mentioned and declared by him to be a *theory*. This shows, that he remained in the faith of his fathers. He ordered to be burned after his death, and the ashes to be scattered over the Himalayas, which stresses his hope, that he waits with all brethren, being burned in German concentration camps, for the resurrection of the dead, according to Ezekiel 37.
